

Important Notice: Upcoming Hydro Rebuild Project in Copper Cliff

Dear Resident,

Greater Sudbury Hydro is committed to modernizing and improving the local distribution system to better serve you, our customer. You are receiving this notice because we will soon begin construction work in your neighbourhood.

Starting as early as **Monday, June 9**, our crews will be working in **Copper Cliff**, with a focus on **Church Street, Peter Street, McKeen Street, Balsam Street, and McNevin Street**. This significant rebuild project is expected to last approximately **two months** and is aimed at improving the reliability and serviceability of your electrical service.

Work will involve pole line upgrades and relocations to support a stronger, more modern distribution network. Our goal is to complete the work with minimal disruption while ensuring long-term benefits for the community.

What to expect:

- You may notice the presence of heavy equipment and construction crews in the area.
- There may be some noise associated with civil work, however, all activities will conform to the City of Greater Sudbury's noise by-law.
- Occasional traffic delays are possible as crews work along the designated streets.
- Hydro-vac excavation work may begin ahead of full construction to prepare pole sites.
- Should any planned power interruptions be required, advance notice will be provided.
