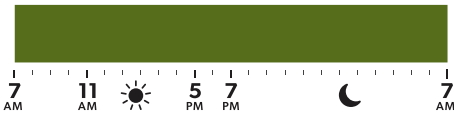

With Tiered prices, you can use a certain amount of electricity each month at a lower price. Once you exceed that limit, a higher price applies.
